Dear Keystone First OB/GYN Provider,

Keystone First's PerformPlus® True Care for Maternity Health Providers, formerly known as our Maternity Quality Enhancement Program (MQEP) is making the following changes to the 2026 program.

The Quality Performance and Health Equity components will still consist of the following two HEDIS® based measures:

- Prenatal Care in the First Trimester
- Postpartum Care

The following Performance component has been updated as follows:

- Relative scaling at 5% intervals begins with the 65th percentile up to the 95th percentile; the aggregate score for the measures is compared to peers.
- Removal of CPT II code electronic submission incentives
- OB/GYN groups at the 75th percentile rank or higher when compared to their peers will be awarded an additional increase in their total earned per delivery payment with regard to the following measures for their Black American population: prenatal care in the first trimester and postpartum care.

Obstetrical Needs Assessment Form (ONAF) Reminder:

- OB/GYN groups will be incentivized for the timely and accurate completion of the ONAF electronic submission for the complete series of the ONAF forms.
- Accurate completion includes complete Provider PROMISe Identification numbers and member Medical Assistance Identification.
- This incentive will be reimbursed during the 4th and final settlement of the program year.
