- Call the Mission GED Hotline at **1-800-573-4100, ext. 5713 (TTY 711)** and ask for an application by mail; **or**
- Download the application at **www.keystonefirstpa.com** → Members → Programs → Mission GED.
- Fill out the Mission GED member application and mail it to the address on the form.
- After we get your application, one of our program coaches will contact you. They will help you sign up for your GED test and connect with other resources in your area.

Am I eligible?

To enroll in Mission GED, you must:

- Be a current member of Keystone First.
- Be 18 years old or older.
- Not have a high school diploma or equivalent.
- Not be currently enrolled in high school or college.

What is Mission GED?

Mission GED is a special program that can help you reach your goal of achieving your GED. This extra benefit is just for Keystone First members.

Mission GED can help with:

- **Testing expenses.** Testing fees can be pretty pricey. When you enroll in Mission GED, Keystone First will provide you with testing vouchers. **Note:** Keystone First will only cover pre-GED and GED test fees. All other costs, such as GED program fees, are the participating member's responsibility.
- **Coaching.** Once you enroll in GED classes, a program coach will work with you every step of the way. Your GED coach will stay in touch to support and encourage you along your GED journey.
- **Internship opportunities.** Hard work should get rewarded! Members who complete Mission GED may qualify for paid internships with Keystone First. These internships help to gain first-hand knowledge and on-the-job training.
