Re: Discontinuation of Dental referral fax forms

To decrease your office's administrative burden, effective immediately Keystone First will discontinue the need to submit a dental referral fax form for reporting purposes. Paper is no longer necessary since EPSDT claim submission guidelines require the dental referral code to be included on claim encounters

As a reminder: All children ages 3 and above must be referred for an annual dental exam as part of each EPSDT Screening. How to report:

- Use the EPSDT modifier EP (Complete Screen) when the process outlined above has been followed.
- Enter the EPSDT referral code YD (dental referral) in field 10d on the CMS 1500 claim form, or field 37 on the UB-04 form.
- When the dental referral has not occurred, submit the claim with the EPSDT modifier 52 (Incomplete Screen).
- Payment for a complete screen is determined by the presence of both the EP modifier and YD referral code.
