**Re: Naloxone Take-Home Distribution by Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHC) and Rural Health Clinics (RHC)**

Keystone First and Keystone First CHC (the “Plan”) are following the guidelines outlined in the Pennsylvania Department of Human Services (DHS) Medical Assistance Bulletin (MAB) 08-21-07 regarding the procedure for submitting claims for a take-home supply of naloxone.

**Please bill the Plan for a take-home supply of nasal or injectable naloxone distributed to Members/Participants as follows:**

1. Procedure code T1015 with all other applicable service codes
2. For reporting and tracking purposes include the recently DHS added zero-pay HCPCS code outlined below on a separate claim line:

<b>Code</b>	<b>Code Description</b>
G2215	Take home supply of nasal naloxone (provision of the services by a Medicare enrolled opioid treatment program); list separately in addition to code for primary procedure
G2216	Take home supply of injectable naloxone (provision of the services by a Medicare-enrolled opioid treatment program); list separately in addition to code for primary procedure
