**Re: Introduction of a new procedure code (T1019) for Electronic Visit verification (EVV) reporting for Personal Care Services (PCS)**

**CORRECTED NOTICE**

**Details:**

Keystone First will follow the Pennsylvania Department of Human Services (DHS) guidelines and will implement the new procedure code T1019 for reporting EVV PCS services for 15-minute units.

Effective for dates of service on or beyond May 1, 2022, EVV PCS services should be reported using T1019 as follows:

Code	Unit Type	Clock-in/Clock-out times
T1019 - Personal Care Services, <b>Per 15 Minutes</b> , Not for An Inpatient Or Resident Of A Hospital, Nursing Facility, ICF/MR or IMD, Part Of The Individualized Plan Of Treatment.	15 minutes	0 minutes – 7 minutes = 0 units 8 minutes – 22 minutes = 1 unit 23 minutes – 37 minutes = 2 units 38 minutes – 52 minutes = 3 units 53 minutes – 67 minutes = 4 units 68 minutes – 82 minutes = 5 units


**Effective for dates of service on or before April 30, 2022 the codes below are still valid codes for reporting EVV PCS:**

S9122 – Home health aide or certified nurse assistant, providing care in the home; **per hour**.

G0156 - Retired code (only for reporting EVV PCS). This is still a valid code for EVV home health care services (HHCS).
